What could be part of their job?

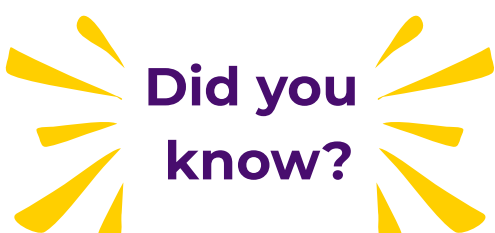
- Arrive at the stadium before the match starts

Could this be for you?

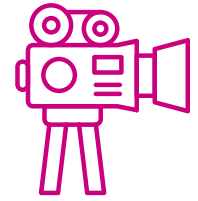
- Take photos or videos of sports and events

- Monitor weather conditions that could affect the playing surface
- Help keep the stadium looking clean and professional
